Hit and Run Collision

On February 3rd 2020 at approximately 9:30 PM Fall River Police Officers responded to the intersection of Rodman Street at Plymouth Avenue in response to a hit and run collision. Witnesses reported that a **Dark Blue Ford F-series Super Duty** was stopped in the right turn lane on the North East corner of the intersection. While a 24 year old Fall River resident was seated on his scooter in the center lane to go straight. When the light turned green, the truck accelerated straight ahead, sideswiping the male on the scooter causing his to crash. The truck stopped, a male exited, looked at the collision, then retreated to the truck fleeing the area North on Hartwell Street. The scooter operator was transported to Rhode Island hospital for treatment of non-life threatening injuries.
