**Omid Kevin White was taken into custody on warrants charging him with:**

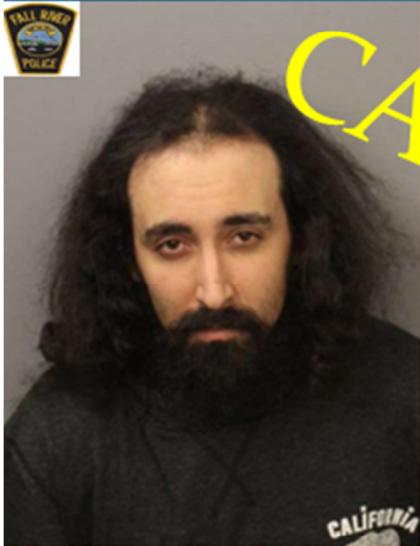

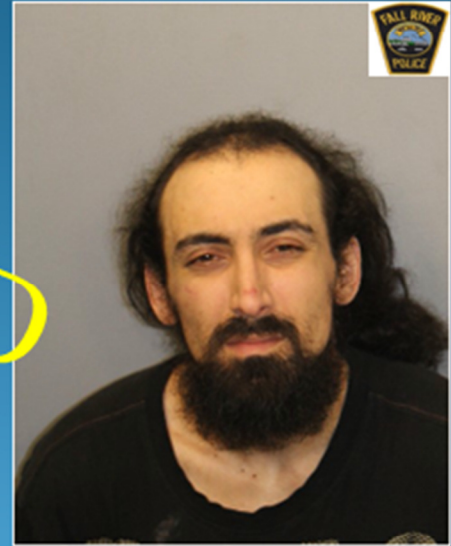
